ASYLUM-SEEKER:

AN INDIVIDUAL SEEKING INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION WHOSE CLAIM HAS NOT YET BEEN FINALLY DECIDED ON. NOT EVERY ASYLUM-SEEKER WILL ULTIMATELY BE RECOGNIZED AS A REFUGEE, BUT EVERY REFUGEE WAS INITIALLY AN ASYLUM-SEEKER.

REFUGEE:

A PERSON LEGALLY RECOGNIZED
AS FLEEING THEIR COUNTRY OF
ORIGIN WHO IS UNABLE OR
UNWILLING TO RETURN BECAUSE
OF A WELL-FOUNDED FEAR OF
PERSECUTION.

INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSON (IDP): similar to refugees, but remain within their own country

STATELESS PERSON: not recognized by their home country

ECONOMIC MIGRANT: voluntarily leaves their home country to live in another country with ostensibly better working or living conditions.





Figure 4 | Refugees, people in refugee-like situations and other people in need of international protection by country of origin | mid-2023
